26 BASIC RULES TO RESPECT IN ENGLISH and a few B2 structures

1. **Simple present** = [V+S with he/she/it] to express habits

Ex: he goes to the library every week

2. **Plural** → plural → plural Sing. → Sing. → Sing.

Ex: lots of people are waiting for the teachers to come.

Ex: A girl is waiting for the teacher to come.

3. **WHO** (with people) ≠ **WHICH** (with objects) and **THAT** (with verbs)

(or **THAT** dans tous les cas)

Ex: the man WHO is brown-haired is my dad

Ex: the book WHICH is over there is mine

Ex: I believe THAT he will arrive on time.

4. **Démonstratifs:**

- **THIS** (singular/proche) **THESE** (plural/proche)

Ex: This girl next to me is my cousin ... These boys here look great!

- **THAT** (singular/loin) **THOSE** (plural/loin)

EX: that girl over there is nice

Those boys over there are singers.

5. Passive voice: **[BE + V-EN]**

Ex: The house is built/ Mark was punished

6. **People** = plural

ex: people are coming

Every + sing.

ex: everybody is coming/ I play tennis every week

7. **Present continuous [BE + V-ING]**

= right now!

Ex: I'm working hard now!

8. Go + **to**...

ex: let's go TO the cinema.

9. Pour = **to + VERB**

Pour = **For + NOUN/or pronoun**

10. **Adjectives of nationality** = capital letter!!

Ex/ **F**rench people/a **S**panish girl...

Months of the year = capital letter!!

Ex/ **O**ctober, **D**ecember...

Days of the week = capital letters !!

Ex/ He is coming this **M**onday.

11. **⊗** (sports)

ex: he plays tennis.

THE (instruments)

ex: he plays the drums.

12. **⊗ countries, except for THE USA / THE UK / THE Netherlands**

Ex: Canada / Spain / France

13. **Les verbes de préférence en anglais:**

Love/like

Enjoy

+ V-ING

ex: I like working outdoor

prefer

hate

14. **Mais si préférence du moment (hypothétique), alors :**

I **would** like

I would love

I would prefer

+ TO+V

ex: but today I would prefer to work in the office.

I would hate

15. WANT + [TO + V]

Ex: I want TO help him.../ She wants TO come with us..../ I want you TO listen....

16. FOR (exprime la durée) **SINCE** (exprime un point de départ, une date) **AGO**= il y a

Ex: I have lived here **for** 10 years

Ex: I have lived here **since** my childhood/ since 2001

Ex: I got married ten years **ago**

17. L'ADJECTIF est épithète (avant le NOM)

Ex: an *easy-going* girl.. / a *red* shoe... / a *French* boy..

18. L'ADJECTIF est INVARIABLE

Ex: a different opinion.../2 different opinions

19. ANOTHER (sing.) /**OTHER** (adj. invariable)/ **OTHERS** (noun)

Ex: The *other* day I bought *another* pair of shoes

Ex: the *others* were too old

20. MODAL + BV (must, may, might, could, can, should, can't...)

Ex: I can go/ you must run/she may be late...

21. Lots of or A lot of ex: a lot of people will come = they drew lots of maps.

22. Il y a ... en anglais = There is.../there are....

23. V+ing = le verbe devient sujet de la phrase

Ex : Using a cell phone when driving is dangerous

24. Après une Préposition, toujours le verbe +-ING

Ex : Instead of going to the park, we could go to the swimming pool.

25. V+ing = present participle

Ex: "I'm glad to be with you," she said smiling
